Each candidate will be assessed on his or her ability & use of the equipment. A written assessment forms part of the assessment, (please inform us ASAP of any special requirements). All candidates have to satisfy the qualified instructors that they are competent to safely operate in a confined space. This will involve practical Breathing Apparatus wearing in confined space scenarios.

Certification:

A valid certificate of competence is awarded to the successful candidate on completion of the course valid for 3 years from issue
